GIFTED TO REVEAL GOD'S GLORY

As we celebrate the anniversary of the descent of the Holy Spirit on the Apostles today, the readings tell us that God comes to us and dwells in us through the Holy Spirit. This has been the will of God from creation. We see God being present with Adam and Eve in the garden of Eden (Gen 3:8-9). In Genesis, God spoke to Jacob in a dream, saying, "Know that I am with you... I will never leave you" (Gen. 28:15). The Gospel reports that "The Word became flesh and *made his dwelling* among us..." (Jn 1:14). In the same Gospel Jesus promises his disciples, "I will not leave you orphans" (Jn 14:18). In today's Gospel passage, Jesus promises "another Advocate to be with you always" (Jn 14:16). Is there any doubt that God will never leave us? As a matter of fact, God is with us, and we are with God.

Today, our Jewish friends celebrate the Feast of Weeks, which commemorates the giving of Law on Mount Sinai. They recall how their ancestors entered a covenant with God, which created a presence and a relationship. This covenant, this promise of God's enduring presence with humanity, began with Noah, given on Mount Sinai to Moses, given at the Last Supper to the Apostles, and now given in the Upper Room to the disciples, and continues to be extended to us today.

Why, God seeks to dwell with us so that his glory will be revealed through us. God created the human person to reveal his glory (Psalm 8). Unfortunately, man's sins distorted creation and hid God's reflection. When we cover God's creation with dirt, we can no longer see the reflection of the creator. Unfortunately, we try to recreate the world with glamour (not glory) with fashions and paintings. We seek energy and strength through drugs and alcohol but not from the Holy Spirit.

God's desire to live with his people is fulfilled with the indwelling of his Spirit in believers. He is within us so that we can have strength in ourselves and not strength in our possessions. He wants to reveal himself to the human person and give man and woman the opportunity to become visible through the manifestation of the Holy Spirit. This is important because the Holy Spirit is with us so that we can reveal the glory of God. He has made us visible through countless works undertaken by the Church to better human lives.

The Holy Spirit is not a fleeting presence in our lives, but a constant companion. He is with us today, continuing Jesus' healing, reconciliation, and restoration work through us. Today, as we reflect on the feast of Pentecost, we are not seeking to receive the Holy Spirit anew—we already have him. Instead, we are called to heed Paul's words to Timothy: "I wish to remind you, Timothy, to fan into flame the gifts in you, which you received on the day I laid my hands on you" (2 Tim 1:6). This reiteration of the continuous presence of the Holy Spirit in our lives serves as a reminder of our constant connection to God and encourages us to live in accordance with the Spirit's guidance.

So, the Holy Spirit has been given and received. We do not receive him and remain the same but equipped and transformed. We now possess an incredible capacity to bring the healing power of the Holy Spirit to restore joy to victims of hardships. Let us then go home to recognize him as a person, visualize him as our couch, and cherish him and his mission in our lives. In so doing, we will not only put our gifts to work but reveal the glory of God in the world.

BENDECIDO PARA REVELAR LA GLORIA DE DIOS

Mientras celebramos hoy el aniversario de la venida del Espíritu Santo sobre los Apóstoles, las lecturas nos dicen que Dios viene a nosotros y mora en nosotros a través del Espíritu Santo. Esta ha sido la voluntad de Dios desde la creación. Vemos a Dios presente con Adán y Eva en el jardín del Edén (Gn 3, 8-9). En Génesis, Dios le habló a Jacob en un sueño y le dijo: "Sabe que yo estoy contigo... nunca te dejaré" (Génesis 28:15). El Evangelio informa que "El Verbo se hizo carne y *habitó* entre nosotros..." (Jn 1,14). En el mismo Evangelio Jesús promete a sus discípulos: "No os dejaré huérfanos" (Jn 14,18). En el pasaje evangélico de hoy, Jesús promete "otro Abogado que estará siempre con vosotros" (Jn 14,16). ¿Hay alguna duda de que Dios nunca nos dejará? De hecho, Dios está con nosotros y nosotros estamos con Dios.

Hoy nuestros amigos judíos celebran la Fiesta de las Semanas que conmemora la entrega de la Ley en el Monte Sinaí. Recuerdan cómo sus antepasados entraron en una alianza con Dios que creó una presencia y una relación. Esta alianza, esta promesa de la presencia perdurable de Dios con la humanidad comenzó con Noé, dada en el Monte Sinaí a Moisés, dada en la Última Cena a los Apóstoles, ahora dada en el Cenáculo a los discípulos, continúa extendiéndose hasta nosotros hoy.

Dios busca habitar con nosotros para que a través de nosotros se revele su gloria. Dios creó a la persona humana para revelar su gloria (Salmo 8). Desafortunadamente, los pecados del hombre distorsionaron la creación y ocultaron el reflejo de Dios. Cuando cubrimos la creación de Dios con la humanidad vemos el reflejo del creador. Desafortunadamente, tratamos de recrear el mundo con glamour (no con gloria) con modas y pinturas. Buscamos energía y fuerza a través de las drogas y el alcohol pero no del Espíritu Santo.

El deseo de Dios de vivir con su pueblo se cumple con la morada de su Espíritu en los creyentes. Él está dentro de nosotros para que podamos tener fuerza en nosotros mismos y no fuerza en nuestras posesiones. Quiere revelarse a la persona humana y dar al hombre y a la mujer la oportunidad de hacerse visibles a través de la manifestación del Espíritu Santo. Esto es importante porque el Espíritu Santo está con nosotros para que podamos revelar la gloria de Dios. Nos ha hecho visibles a través de innumerables obras emprendidas por la Iglesia para mejorar la vida humana.

El Espíritu Santo está con nosotros hoy para continuar la obra de sanación, reconciliación y restauración de Jesús a través de nosotros. Hoy no estamos celebrando la fiesta de Pentecostés para recibir de nuevo el Espíritu Santo, ya lo tenemos. En cambio, estamos haciendo lo que Pablo le dice a Timoteo: "Quiero recordarte, Timoteo, que avives el fuego de los dones que recibiste el día en que te impuse las manos" (2 Timoteo 1:6).

Entonces, el Espíritu Santo ha sido dado y recibido. No lo recibimos y seguimos siendo los mismos pero equipados y transformados. Ahora poseemos una capacidad increíble para traer el poder sanador del Espíritu Santo para restaurar el gozo a las víctimas de las dificultades. Vayamos entonces a casa para reconocerlo como persona, visualizarlo como nuestro sofá y apreciarlo a él y su misión en nuestras vidas. Al hacerlo, no solo pondremos nuestros dones a trabajar, sino que revelaremos la gloria de Dios en el mundo.
