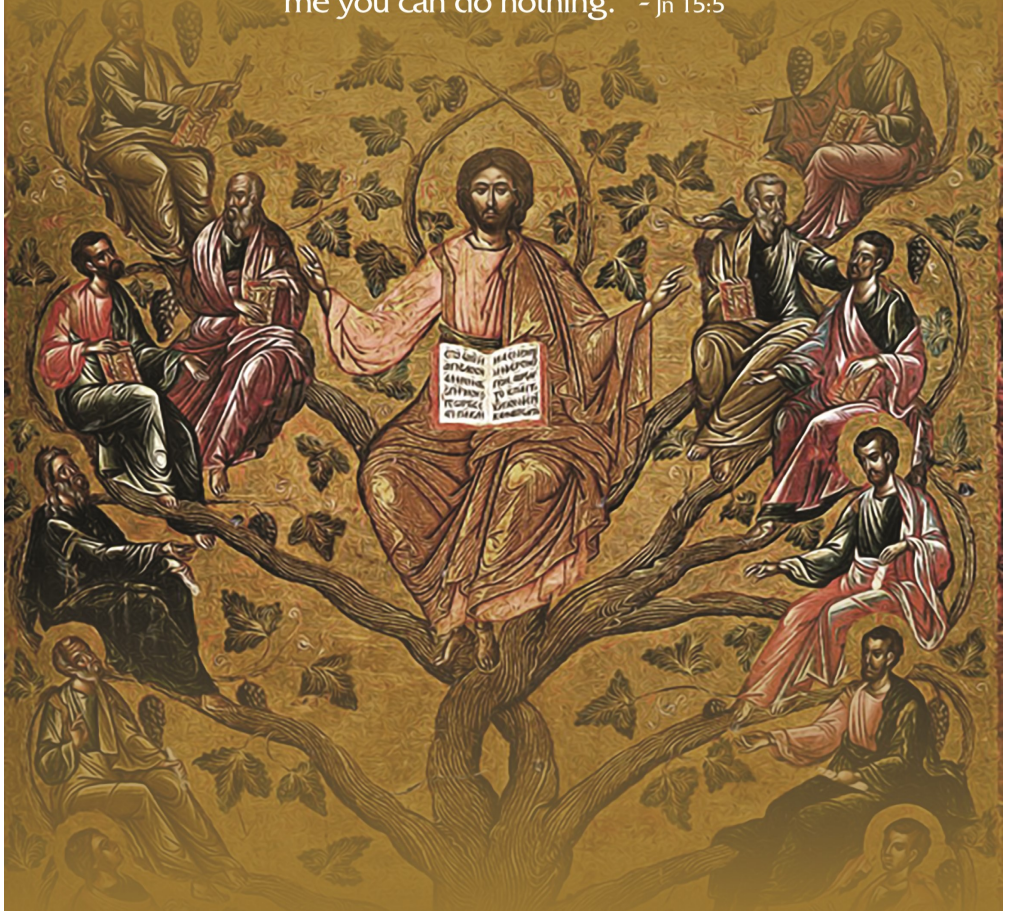

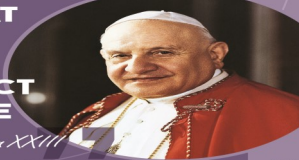

ST. JOHN XXIII, THE GOOD POPE

Today, as we celebrate the tenth anniversary of the canonization of our patron saint, our reflection is directed to his areas of life and work that won him the title of a "Good Pope." St. John XXIII was known for his friendliness. On the day of his beatification, Pope John Paul II said in his homily: "Today we contemplate in the glory of John XXIII, the Pope who impressed the world with the friendliness of his manner which radiated the remarkable goodness of his soul. Everyone remembers the image of Pope John's smiling face and two outstretched arms embracing the whole world. How many people were won over by his simplicity of heart, combined with a broad experience of people and things!" (September 3, 2000).

St. John XXIII, formerly known as, Angelo Giuseppe Roncalli, was born on November 25, 1881, ordained a priest August 10, 1904, consecrated a bishop in Rome on March 19, 1925, died June 3, 1963, beatified September 3, 2000 and canonized April 27, 2014.

Our patron saint was known for his humility. In his last will and testament, he wrote: "Born poor, but of humble and respected folk, I am particularly happy to die poor. "I thank God for this grace of poverty to which I vowed fidelity in my youth... which has strengthened me in my resolve never to ask for anything -- positions, money or favors -- never either for myself or for my relations and friends." No wonder when he died in June 1963, he was mourned worldwide as "The Good Pope."

Our patron saint was known for his crusade for peace and justice. During the Second World War, as an archbishop serving as head of the Vatican's diplomatic mission to Turkey and Greece, he helped save the lives of many Jews fleeing the Holocaust by providing them with transit visas and other vital paperwork that allowed them to leave Europe.

Again, in October 1962, with the U.S. and Russia teetering on the brink of nuclear war, Pope John XXIII helped to bring both countries back from the edge, urging President J. F. Kennedy and Russian leader Nikita Khrushchev to exercise restraint for the good of the people. Days after the Pope's address, Khrushchev began withdrawing Russian missiles from Cuba, defusing the crisis. Months later, John XXIII published the *encyclical "Pacem in Terris"* ("Peace on Earth"), addressed "to all men of goodwill" and called on the world's populations to co-exist in harmony. He did this because he had the well-being of the people at heart.

Our parish patron saint was a great reformer. In his beatification homily, Pope John II further said: "The breath of newness Pope John XXIII brought certainly did not concern doctrine, but rather the way to explain it; his style of speaking and acting was new, as was his friendly approach to ordinary people and to the powerful of the world. It was in this spirit that he called the Second Vatican Ecumenical Council, thereby turning a new page in the Church's history: Christians heard themselves called to proclaim the Gospel with renewed courage and greater attentiveness to the "signs" of the times. Amid many difficulties, he opened a season of hope for Christians and humanity.

As a good Pope, in the last moments of his earthly life, he entrusted his testament to the Church: "What counts the most in life is blessed Jesus Christ, his holy Church, his Gospel, truth and goodness." Our next duty after Today's celebration of the tenth anniversary of the canonization of St. John XXIII is to see how what we now know about him will help transform how we respond to our Christian calling and the life of the parish. All we can ask is: "St. John, pray for us so that as a community named after you, we shall be able to imitate your vision, spirituality, personality, love for the Church, and pastoral zeal. Amen.

SAN JUAN XXIII, EL BUEN PAPA

Hoy, al celebrar el décimo aniversario de la canonización de nuestro santo patrón, nuestra reflexión se dirige a las áreas de su vida y obra que le valieron el título de "Buen Papa". San Juan XXIII era conocido por su amabilidad. El día de su beatificación, el Papa Juan Pablo II dijo en su homilía: "Hoy contemplamos en la gloria de Juan XXIII al Papa que impresionó al mundo con la amabilidad de sus modales que irradiaban la notable bondad de su alma. Todos recuerdan la imagen del rostro sonriente del Papa Juan y de sus dos brazos extendidos abrazando al mundo entero. ¡Cuántas personas fueron conquistadas por su sencillez de corazón, combinada con una amplia experiencia de las personas y de las cosas!" (3 de septiembre de 2000).

San Juan XXIII, anteriormente conocido como Angelo Giuseppe Roncalli, nació el 25 de noviembre de 1881, fue ordenado sacerdote el 10 de agosto de 1904, consagrado obispo en Roma el 19 de marzo de 1925, murió el 3 de junio de 1963, beatificado el 3 de septiembre. 2000 y canonizado el 27 de abril de 2014.

Nuestro santo patrón era conocido por su humildad. En su última voluntad y testamento, escribió: "Nacido pobre, pero de gente humilde y respetada, estoy especialmente feliz de morir pobre. "Doy gracias a Dios por esta gracia de la pobreza a la que juré fidelidad en mi juventud... que me ha fortalecido en mi determinación de no pedir nunca nada -puestos, dinero o favores-, nunca ni para mí ni para mis parientes y amigos". No es de extrañar que cuando murió en junio de 1963, fuera llorado en todo el mundo como "El Buen Papa".

Nuestro santo patrón fue conocido por su cruzada por la paz y la justicia. Durante la Segunda Guerra Mundial, como arzobispo y jefe de la misión diplomática del Vaticano en Turquía y Grecia, ayudó a salvar las vidas de muchos judíos que huían del Holocausto proporcionándoles visas de tránsito y otros trámites vitales que les permitieron salir de Europa.

Nuevamente, en octubre de 1962, con Estados Unidos y Rusia al borde de una guerra nuclear, el Papa Juan XXIII ayudó a sacar a ambos países del borde del abismo, instando al presidente J. F. Kennedy y al líder ruso Nikita Khrushchev a actuar con moderación por el bien del pueblo. . Días después del discurso del Papa, Jruschov comenzó a retirar misiles rusos de Cuba, desactivando la crisis. Meses después, Juan XXIII publicó la encíclica "*Pacem in Terris*" ("Paz en la Tierra"), dirigida "a todos los hombres de buena voluntad" y llamaba a las poblaciones del mundo a convivir en armonía. Lo hizo porque se preocupaba por el bienestar del pueblo.

Nuestro santo patrón parroquial fue un gran reformador. En su homilía de beatificación, el Papa Juan II dijo además: "El soplo de novedad que trajo el Papa Juan XXIII ciertamente no se refería a la doctrina, sino más bien a la manera de explicarla; su estilo de hablar y actuar era nuevo, como también lo era su trato amistoso con los ordinarios. y a los poderosos del mundo. Con este espíritu convocó el Concilio Ecuménico Vaticano II, abriendo así una nueva página en la historia de la Iglesia: los cristianos se sintieron llamados a anunciar el Evangelio con renovado coraje y mayor atención a los "signos" de los tiempos. En medio de muchas dificultades, abrió un tiempo de esperanza para los cristianos y la humanidad.

Como buen Papa, en los últimos momentos de su vida terrena confió a la Iglesia su testamento: "Lo que más cuenta en la vida es bendito Jesucristo, su santa Iglesia, su Evangelio, su verdad y su bondad". Nuestro próximo deber después de la celebración de hoy del décimo aniversario de la canonización de San Juan XXIII es ver cómo lo que ahora sabemos sobre él ayudará a transformar la forma en que respondemos a nuestro llamado cristiano y la vida de la parroquia. Lo único que podemos pedir es: "San Juan, ruega por nosotros para que, como comunidad que lleva tu nombre, podamos imitar tu visión, espiritualidad, personalidad, amor a la Iglesia y celo pastoral. Amén.
