REMAIN IN MY LOVE

The Scripture teaches us that *God is love* (1 John 4:8), and everything he does flows from his immense love for us. He loved us so much that he was willing to pay any price to redeem us from our slavery to sin and death. Paul tells us that this love of God has been poured into our hearts (Rom 5:5). As such, we are not only beneficiaries but also have the potential to love as Jesus does. This is so because love has the power to change and transform us to be like him - merciful, gracious, kind, forgiving, compassionate, and charitable. Hence, in today's Gospel passage, Jesus is not only asking us to love but to remain in his love.

This leads us to one of the greatest problems in Christianity – the ability to remain in Christ. It is one thing to profess faith and love for God but another to remain rooted in one's commitment. So, to remain describes the power of self-sacrificing love to make God visible in our midst – God's love for us, our love for one another, and all others. It does not only show that we are his disciples but that we belong to him, whose love does not come to an end.

The invitation to remain in his love challenges the exuberance of those of us who make promises when the journey is fresh and smooth but fail when the going becomes difficult. I have seen this among the newly baptized adults. Some promise to love God with great zeal but cannot remain steadfast in their love for God with time. It is not enough to believe and be baptized but to remain faithful, dedicated, and loving in the face of challenges and temptations. Jesus wants us to love and obey God and his Church at a young age and old age, season and out of season.

This calls for love, which includes fondness and trust, for a loving relationship that goes beyond mere duty and obedience. Jesus tells us in today's Gospel that such a love disposes a man to give his all for those he loves. "Greater love has no man than this: that a man lay down his life for his friends. You are my friends if you do what I command you. No longer do I call you servants, for the servant does not know what his master is doing; but I have called you friends, for all that I have heard from my Father I have made known to you" (John 15:13-14). This note of familiarity, trust, and care is the ingredient with which we can remain in love with each other.

It is the culture of the Jews to call one who trains under a teacher a slave or servant. As dropouts from rabbinical schools are called to follow Jesus, the relationship starts as a master-servant, but Jesus transforms it into friendship. Jesus considers this change very important and will change how disciples relate to him. He wants us to relate intimately to him with freedom, openness, confidence, and without fear. In relationships of this kind, lovers feel more appreciated and loved.

One of the special marks of favor shown in the Scriptures is to be called the *friend of God*, like Abraham who is called the *friend of God* (Isaiah 41:8, James 2:23), or Moses to whom God spoke as a man speaks with his friend (Exodus 33:11). Both Abraham and Moses did not only love God but remained steadfast in their love with God. They served with a single-minded commitment. Today, Jesus calls us to do the same by obeying the commandments and having resilient faith in the face of daily changes. "The more we share the life of Christ and progress in his friendship, the more difficult it is to break away from him by mortal sin" (*Catechism of the Catholic Church*, no. 1395).

PERMANECE EN MI AMOR

Las Escrituras nos enseñan que Dios es amor (1 Juan 4:8), y todo lo que hace fluye de su inmenso amor por nosotros. Nos amó tanto que estuvo dispuesto a pagar cualquier precio para redimirnos de nuestra esclavitud al pecado y la muerte. Pablo nos dice que este amor de Dios ha sido derramado en nuestros corazones (Romanos 5:5). Como tal, no sólo somos beneficiarios sino que también tenemos el potencial de amar como lo hace Jesús. Esto es así porque el amor tiene el poder de cambiarnos y transformarnos para que seamos como él: misericordiosos, bondadosos, bondadosos, compasivos y caritativos. Por lo tanto, en el pasaje del Evangelio de hoy, Jesús no sólo nos pide amar, sino permanecer en su amor.

Esto nos lleva a uno de los mayores problemas del cristianismo: la capacidad de permanecer en Cristo. Una cosa es profesar la fe y el amor a Dios, pero otra permanecer arraigado en el propio compromiso. Entonces, permanecer describe el poder del amor abnegado para hacer visible a Dios entre nosotros: el amor de Dios por nosotros, nuestro amor mutuo y por todos los demás. No sólo muestra que somos sus discípulos sino que pertenecemos a él, cuyo amor no tiene fin.

La invitación a permanecer en su amor desafía la exuberancia de aquellos de nosotros que hacemos promesas cuando el viaje es fresco y tranquilo pero fracasamos cuando el camino se vuelve difícil. He visto esto entre los adultos recién bautizados. Algunos prometen amar a Dios con gran celo pero no pueden permanecer firmes en su amor por Dios con el tiempo. No basta con creer y ser bautizado sino permanecer fiel, dedicado y amoroso ante los desafíos y las tentaciones. Jesús quiere que amemos y obedezcamos a Dios y a su Iglesia en la juventud y en la vejez, a tiempo y a destiempo.

Esto requiere amor, que incluye cariño y confianza, para una relación amorosa que vaya más allá del mero deber y obediencia. Jesús nos dice en el Evangelio de hoy que tal amor dispone al hombre a darlo todo por aquellos a quienes ama. "Nadie tiene mayor amor que este: que uno ponga su vida por sus amigos. Vosotros sois mis amigos si hacéis lo que yo os mando. Ya no os llamo siervos, porque el siervo no sabe quién es su señor. haciendo; pero os he llamado amigos, porque todo lo que he oído de mi Padre os lo he hecho saber" (Juan 15:13-14). Esta nota de familiaridad, confianza y cuidado es el ingrediente con el que podemos seguir en amor los unos a otros.

Es la cultura de los judíos llamar esclavo o sirviente a quien se entrena con un maestro. Cuando los que abandonan las escuelas rabínicas son llamados a seguir a Jesús, la relación comienza como amo-siervo, pero Jesús la transforma en amistad. Jesús considera este cambio muy importante y cambiará la forma en que los discípulos se relacionan con él. Quiere que nos relacionemos íntimamente con él con libertad, apertura, confianza y sin miedo. En relaciones de este tipo, los amantes se sienten más apreciados y amados.

Una de las marcas especiales de favor que se muestran en las Escrituras es ser llamado amigo de Dios, como Abraham, a quien se llama amigo de Dios (Isaías 41:8, Santiago 2:23), o Moisés a quien Dios habló como hombre. habla con su amigo (Éxodo 33:11). Tanto Abraham como Moisés no sólo amaron a Dios sino que permanecieron firmes en su amor por Dios. Sirvieron con un compromiso decidido. Hoy, Jesús nos llama a hacer lo mismo obedeciendo los mandamientos y teniendo una fe resiliente ante los cambios diarios. "Cuanto más compartimos la vida de Cristo y progresamos en su amistad, más difícil es romper con Él por el pecado mortal" (*Catecismo de la Iglesia Católica*, n. 1395).

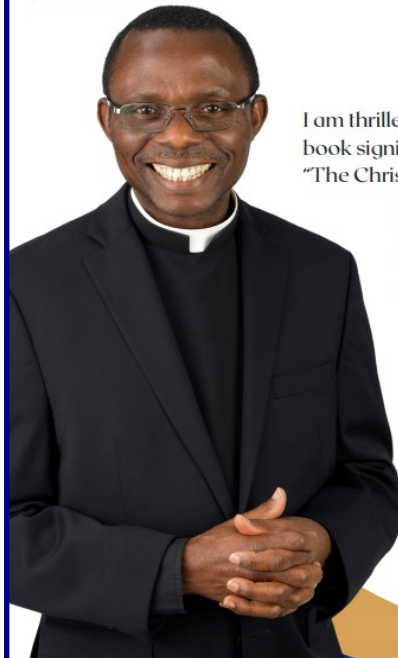
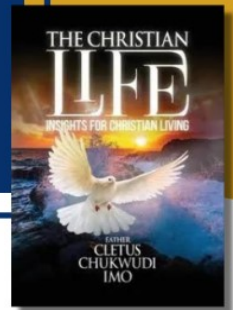
